Focus for Lower Primary



- Arouse curiosity
- Encourage them to explore
- Make learning fun
- Lay strong foundations to develop attitude and dispositions to form friendships and motivation to learn
- No weighted assessments
- Holistic feedback through rubrics, checklists, daily work

Desired Outcomes



• For students, staff, parents and wider community

"Feeling Good and Doing Good"

- "Feeling Good" —cultivating resilience and healthy levels of optimism ,vitality and emotional stability
- "<u>Doing Good</u>"-caring for others by nurturing positive relationships and using one's skills and knowledge to contribute to society





Preparation for PI Transition



- Your child will face new places, people, rules and relationships. This
 can be both exciting and frightening.
 - Encourage him/her to talk about his/her experience and assure him/her in a positive manner (e.g. expression of his feelings, give ideas of how she/he can relate, ask for help)
- You can encourage your child to be familiar with his/her new school environment right from today.
 - Encourage your child to go to the General Office or seek help from any adult in school
- Point out the school whenever you pass it.
 - Communicate how/when he/she will be picked up after school
- Tell stories about what you enjoyed at school and the fun things you did (use of positive language).

How parents can support the school's efforts

- Take care of your child's holistic well-being
 - Adequate rest and exercise and a balanced diet lead to a more alert mind and healthy body
- Unconditional love and acceptance
- Encourage and Affirm your child catch him /her doing right, focus on the positive
- Support child in attending school
- Make time for your child









Share important information

Share information on child with school/teachers that will help us to understand child better

Examples:

- Specific needs behavioral/learning
- Child's anxiety



How parents can support the school's efforts



Communications with the school:

- Letters via PG
- Newsletters
- Champions Handbook
- Email to the Form teachers/ Subject
 Teachers/ School
- Class Dojo





How parents can support the school's efforts



- Be contactable
- Keep communication channels open – seek clarification, school welcomes feedback
- Be mindful of teachers' wellbeing
- Attend school briefings
- Reinforce school's expectations at home





School-Home Partnership is Important

We seek parents' understanding, especially in the following areas:

- No celebration of birthdays
- Seek clarification and give feedback
- Support and cooperation in Safety Management Measures (SMM, if any) and school rules
